KTLA Feature Reporter Gayle Anderson, KLAC Sportscaster Vic “The Brick” Jacobs, and KPCC Talk Show Host Larry Mantle to Be Honored by Southern California Broadcasters

(Universal City, Calif.) Award-winning KTLA-TV feature reporter Gayle Anderson, one of the most distinctive voices in sports radio in Southern California, Vic “The Brick” Jacobs, and longtime KPCC-FM radio talk show host Larry Mantle will be honored with Lifetime Achievement Awards at the 69th Annual Golden Mike Awards®, presented by the Radio & Television News Association of Southern California (RTNA).

Anderson is a Golden Mike Award® and Emmy® Award-winning feature reporter who has been bringing unique stories to Southern California television viewers for 25 years, as a part of the KTLA Morning News. While known for her light-hearted approach to stories we often don’t see on TV, she has also switched gears to provide award-winning coverage of hard news stories like earthquakes and brush fires.

Jacobs has been a television and radio sportscaster in Los Angeles for three decades. His distinctive on-air delivery has made him a hit with sports fans, and his knowledge of sports has made him a favorite journalist of many pro athletes. He’s co-hosted local and national sports talk shows with some of the biggest names in the sports world.

Mantle has hosted the longest continuously-running talk show in Los Angeles for more than three decades. The award-winning broadcast journalist has been the voice of “Airtalk” on KPCC since 1985, interviewing thousands of people. He also hosts the popular “Film Week” movie review/interview program on the station.

Anderson, Jacobs, and Mantle will be saluted January 19th at the Universal Hilton in Universal City, as part of the 69th Annual Golden Mike Awards®. During the program, the best in broadcast journalism (radio and television) in Southern and Central California will also be honored.

The Golden Mike Awards® are presented each year by the Radio & Television News Association of Southern California, a nonprofit organization representing broadcast news professionals throughout Southern California. RTNA coordinates TV pool coverage of major news events in the region, champions freedom of information causes, and provides scholarships for the next generation of broadcast journalists.
